## *Background*

Our Viña Mariposa wines are specially produced by one of the best co-operatives in Northern Spain. The co-operative started life as a passionate personal project more than 50 years ago. Although the scale of the company has grown, they have maintained the same family character and traditions. Situated in Galicia, they have long-standing detailed contracts with local growers at five large bodegas and purchase only the highest quality fruit. By overseeing the growing of the grapes and sourcing fruit from several different areas, they are able to choose the definitive flavour characteristics desired. The co-operative also has an extensive, state-of-the-art modern winery.

## *Winemaking*

Only the highest quality fruit is used in order to preserve freshness of character and avoid oxidation. The grapes are fermented at low temperatures in stainless steel tanks before being cold-stabilised. Prior to bottling, the wine is filtered.

## *Tasting & Pairing*

Bright raspberry appearance. Intense red fruit aromas; strawberries and light hints of floral notes. On the palate, the fruity characteristics of a bright Rosé appear with refreshing acidity. Persistent finish.

Great as an aperitif, with light canapés
