## *Background*

This Rioja Baja based winery started in the 1950s by selling wine in bulk, and today is run by six families and operates from a modern cellar in the town of Alfaro.

## *Winemaking*

After gentle pressing, temperature controlled fermentation occurs in stainless steel tanks followed by 3 months maturation on fine lees to build complexity.

## *Tasting & Pairing*

Bright and pale with aromas of crisp green apple, pear and lemon. Background notes of peach and slight nutty character. A well balanced wine with a good finish.

A good aperitif and also with grilled fish and seafood.
