Background

This property is owned by Jean Claude Giraud who was cellar master at Eglise Clinet in Pomerol for 20 years before returning to take over his family's vineyards. The small 1.5 hectare plot and its limestone clay soils allow the Merlot to ripen perfectly, giving the wines body and finesse.

Winemaking

Fruit is picked from vines with an average age of 17 years and barrel aged for a soft, velvety wine.

Tasting & Pairing

A rich and deep wine with violet hues. Red cherry and red current aromas with a touch of blossom and vanilla. Ripe blackberry and blueberry on the palate; well balanced with a long finish.

Enjoy with a steak or venison wellington.
