Background

This Saint Julien comes from a 1 hectare plot of clay, gravel and sandy soil on the Château du Glana estate and is one of the rare crus Bourgeois of the appellation. The wine is made in their cellar by Gabriel Meffre and his team.

Winemaking & Winemaker

Once fruit is picked and vinified, wine is aged in 45% new and 55% old oak barrels for a silky wine.

Sustainability

HVE Level 3 certified, this guarantee ensures the estate abides by rules to protect the local environment for future generations to enjoy. Including resource management (fuels, water, electricity), promoting biodiversity in the vineyards and strict restrictions on herbicide usage.

Tasting & Pairing

A well structured wine. It has a perfumed nose of blackberries, red plums, and spice with a palate of silky dark fruit and gentle tannins.

Best served with game and red meat dishes.
