Background

This 11 hectare property is planted on the well-drained sand and gravel of the Coutelin commune. The vineyard was classed as a Cru Bourgeois in 2011 before being bought by business man Chris Cardon in 2015. Along with consultant Eric Boissenot, they make an approachable style of Saint-Estèphe.

Winemaking

Once fruit is picked and vinified, wine is aged in part new and old French oak to develop the wine's characteristics and add body and depth.

Well balanced wine with lots of red cherry and black plum aromas and a hint of cedar and spice in the background. An elegance Saint-Estèphe that can be enjoyed for many years to come
