Background

Château de Corneilla was built in the XIIth century by the Knight Templars. Philippe Jonqueres d'Oriola the current owner, now works with his son William, who represents the 27th generation of winegrowers in the family.

Winemaking

After a manual harvest on the clay-stoney soil, grapes are crushed and undergo fermentation in oak for up to fourteen days (20°C-32°C) to gain full extraction of colour and tannins from the skins. Pumping over occurs before pressing and blending. Matured in French oak for 12 months.

Tasting & Pairing

Intense red with purple reflections. Lots of red and black fruit on the nose with hints of spice, this is reflected on the palate with lots of fruit and soft, silky tannins and toasted notes.

Pairs well with grilled steak and red meats, alternatively, with slow cooked porcini and lentil dishes.
