Background

Château de Corneilla was built in the XIIth century by the Knight Templars. Philippe Jonqueres d'Oriola the current owner, now works with his son William, who represents the 27th generation of winegrowers in the family.

Winemaking

After a manual harvest on the clay-stoney soil, grapes are pressed using a pneumatic press before undergoing fermentation at a low temperature (12°C-22°C) to preserve the distinctive fruit aromas. Aged in French oak for 3 weeks and ageing on fine lees in Stainless steel tanks.

Tasting & Pairing

Pale pink in colour with fresh, expressive notes of raspberries and strawberries. The palate is fresh and refined with a good balance.

Excellent as an apertif, grilled white fish and light salads.
