Background

Founded in 2004 by Kate Acland, the 21 hectare estate is made up of Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay and Riesling, the winery also have close relationships with a small number of growers across the Wairu and Awatere valleys. The Orchard Lane label embodies the care and passion Kate and her team strive for after each harvest. Their aim is to “make great wine without the fuss”.

Winemaking

Fruit picked and crushed, gently pressed and the resulting juice is settled before being cool fermented in stainless steel using different yeasts to add complexity. The wines are blended and balanced shortly after completing fermentation and prepared for bottling.

Sustainability

Taking on a '100 year view on every decision we make on our farm and vineyards' has meant that the winery has been certified sustainable through Sustainable Winegrowing New Zealand (SWNZ). The estate have cattle, sheep and honey being produced, inviting new habitats into the vineyards and boosting the biodiversity of the area.

Tasting & Pairing

Ripe, tropical aromas, hints of passionfruit and mango. A rich palate of citrus fruit, lemon and grapefruit balance nicely with acidity and finish.

Excellent with shellfish and light salads.
