Background

This winemaking venture was set up by Rober to Mazzei in 1981 and today is run by his son, Andreas. Based just north of Milan they make and bottle a number of wines to showcase the excellent grape varieties that Italy produces.

Winemaking

Grapes are picked from vineyards located in Venice and nearby Treviso. Once pressed, the juice undergoes slow fermentation with peel for a short period to encourage a light colour extraction resulting in a delicate appearance. Wine is aged for 4 months in stainless steel tanks; preserving the flavour profile and maintaining its freshness.

Tasting & Pairing

Attractive pale pink with a light, aromatic nose of starwberry and red cherry.

A great apertif or with a light salad and grilled seafood.
