Climate, viticulture, winemaking

The small 1.5 hectare plot and its limestone clay soils allow the Merlot to ripen perfectly, giving the wines body and finesse.

Fruit is picked from vines with an average age of 17 years and barrel aged for a soft, velvety wine.



Tasting Notes

A rich and deep wine with violet hues. Red cherry and red current aromas with a touch of blossom and vanilla. Ripe blackberry and blueberry on the palate; well balanced with a long finish.
