The Geromin family transformed the 11 hectares of former agricultural plot that included old vines and is today run by 2 sisters, Audrey and Marion Geromin. Audrey Geromin learnt her trade at La Tour Blanche and is now lead winemaker at the estate.

Climate, viticulture, winemaking

Based 17km from Saint Emilion on the clay-limestone Coubeyrac plateau. Fruit is picked from the 30 year old vines and vinified in stainless steel tanks. The wine spends some time in oak before being bottled.



Tasting Notes

Bright cherry red colour with gentle hints of cinammon and vanilla on the nose. Ample structure with good length and gentle tannins.
