## Producer

---

Formed in 1952, the Cave Vinicole de Hunawihr co-operative currently has 130 members. Situated around the village of Hunawihr, (9km northwest of Colmar) this co-op consists of family-owned winegrowers with a total vineyard coverage of 210 hectares. Anthony Bondon is the lead winemaker.

## Climate, viticulture, winemaking

---

The calcareous soil provides excellent vine-growing conditions. Located in the foothills of the Vosges mountain range, the region is characterised by undulating hillsides and very little rainfall.

Harvest takes place from mid-September - October with the grapes being either machine or hand-harvested depending on their location on the sloping hillside. Cool fermentation lasts between 14 - 21 days. In order to preserve the purity of flavour and nuances of character, the wine does not go through malolactic fermentation. Ageing on fine lees occurs for a minimum of three months prior to bottling.



## Tasting Notes

---

Fresh, crisp green apple aromas with delicate notes of white blossom. Round and succulent on the palate with inviting flavours of juicy citrus, lime and green apple. Zippy acidity on the finish with great length.
