## Producer

---

Formed in 1952, the Cave Vinicole de Hunawihr co-operative currently has 130 members. Situated around the village of Hunawihr, (9km northwest of Colmar) this co-op consists of family-owned winegrowers with a total vineyard coverage of 210 hectares. Anthony Bondon is the lead winemaker.

## Climate, viticulture, winemaking

---

The calcareous soil provides excellent vine-growing conditions. Located in the foothills of the Vosges mountain range, the region is characterised by undulating hillsides and very little rainfall.

Only 50 sites within the cooperative have been awarded Grand Cru status. The noble grapes are grown in homogenous soil on a south/south-east exposure. The Schoenenbourg site is situated North of Riuewihr at an altitude of 260-380m on a very steep hillside.



## Tasting Notes

Powerful and rich, lots of stone fruit, peach and apricot on the nose with hints of ginger spice on the palate.
