Climate, viticulture, winemaking

Produced in an extensive, state-of-the-art modern winery by a very experienced team. Only the highest quality fruit is used in order to preserve freshness of character and avoid oxidation. The grapes are fermented at low temperatures in stainless steel tanks before being cold-stabilised. Prior to bottling, the wine is filtered.



Tasting Notes

A bright, approachable style with inviting aromas of ripe red cherries and bramble fruits. Well-integrated tannins create a smooth palate, soft in texture with layers of berry flavours, violets and liquorice intertwined with sweet spice.
