Climate, viticulture, winemaking

Produced in an extensive, state-of-the-art modern winery by a very experienced team. Only the highest quality fruit is used in order to preserve freshness of character and avoid oxidation. The grapes are fermented at low temperatures in stainless steel tanks before being cold-stabilised. Prior to bottling, the wine is filtered.



Tasting Notes

Bright raspberry appearance. Intense red fruit aromas; strawberries and light hints of floral notes. On the palate, the fruity characteristics of a bright Rosé appear with refreshing acidity.
