Husband and wife team Kate and David Acland own the 21 hectare estate and lead winemaking. Their family have five generations of farming experience behind them and their enterprise includes sheep, cattle and honey production.

Climate, viticulture, winemaking

The estate is made up of Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay and Riesling, the winery also have close relationships with a small number of growers across the Wairu and Awatere valleys. The Orchard Lane label embodies the care and passion Kate and her team strive to “make great wine without the fuss”. Fruit picked, crushed and gently pressed before settling. Cool fermentation in stainless steel tanks using different yeasts to add complexity. The wines are blended and balanced shortly after completing fermentation and prepared for bottling.



Tasting Notes

Ripe, tropical aromas, hints of passionfruit and mango. A rich palate of citrus fruit, lemon and grapefruit balance nicely with acidity and finish.

Taking on a ‘100 year view’ on every decision that’s made on the farm and vineyards means that the winery has been certified sustainable through Sustainable Winegrowing New Zealand (SWNZ). The estate’s other production ventures also help boost biodiversity in the local area.
