Father and son, Roberto and Andreas Mazzei took on Cascina Radice winery in the 90s. The pair have worked tirelessly to modernise production without compromising on the passion and care required to maintain the vineyards.

Climate, viticulture, winemaking

The property dates back to the 1890s and is surrounded by the hilly countryside in the small town of Moasca. Vineyards located in the area of Neive and Treiso (Cuneo).

Fruit is macerated over a 12 day period under controlled temperatures in stainless steel tanks. This retains as much aroma and characteristics of the fruit as possible. For greater extractions, pumping over occurs to deepen colour and tannins. Wine is oaked for 24 months in barrels then a further 6 months ageing in bottle.



Tasting Notes

Garnet appearance with an intense nose of red cherry and redcurrant. Earthy mushroom notes with a hint of white pepper in the background support this classic Barbaresco.
