### Producer

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Father and son, Roberto and Andreas Mazzei took on Cascina Radice winery in the 90s. The pair have worked tirelessly to modernise production without compromising on the passion and care required to maintain the vineyards.

### Climate, viticulture, winemaking

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The property dates back to the 1890s and is surrounded by the hilly countryside in the small town of Moasca. Vineyards based in the area of La Morra in Cuneo.

Grapes are picked around mid-October, peel maceration and fermentation occurs over a period of 12 days in stainless steel tanks at 28°c to preserve the profile of the fruit. Ageing in oak over 36 months and a further 3 in the bottle.



### Tasting Notes

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Complex aromas of violet, vanilla and chocolate. Full bodied, dry and juicy on the palate with excellent balance of tannins and acidity, providing excellent structure.
