Father and son, Roberto and Andreas Mazzei took on Cascina Radice winery in the 90s. The pair have worked tirelessly to modernise production without compromising on the passion and care required to maintain the vineyards.

Climate, viticulture, winemaking

The property dates back to the 1890s and is surrounded by the hilly countryside in the small town of Moasca. The vineyards are based in the areas of Gavi (Alessandria).

Grapes are picked, pressed and vinified in stainless steel, temperature controlled tanks to retain the fruit characteristics of the juice. Wine is aged for 4-6 months before bottling.



Tasting Notes

Pale in colour, there are fresh, aromatic notes of citrus and green apple. on the nose. A hint of nuttines in the background. Crisp and fresh on the palate with good acidity and minerality with subtle hints of herb.
