Gérard Crozet cultivates the vines, whilst his daughter Anaïs oversees the operations and cellar. Their aim is simple: to produce artisan wines while respecting the nature that surrounds them.

Climate, viticulture, winemaking

The heart of the estate is located in a place called "La Folie" on steep, sloping land. Vines cover 6 hectares in the Beaujolais-Villages appellation and are planted in clay-granite and volcanic soils.

Fruit is hand-harvested, before undergoing carbonic maceration over a period of 10-15 days. Ageing in vats for 7-8 months occurs before a very light filtration to preserve the wine's characteristics.



Tasting Notes

Deep garnet with classic red fruit aromas; kirsch, raspberries and strawberries. Round structure with gentle tannins and long finish.

Good to know

Vegetarian, Vegan friendly. The estate does not use harmful chemicals or pesticides on the vines, instead, opting for daily observations to pick out any problems early. Anaïs and Gérard own 0.25 hectares of organic vines for a small part of their production.
