Climate, viticulture, winemaking

With 32 hectares of south-facing vineyards in the south of Rheinhessen, the hilly landscape of Bechtheim is characterised by its striking basin formation. This topography lends itself to a unique set of conditions to the growth of high quality grapes.

Vineyard is grown in loess-clay soils with slightly acidic, iron rich sections. 100% of pressed juice is vinified in small oak barrels.



Tasting Notes

Elegant example of a German Pinot Noir. Delicate red fruit aromas with spiced background notes. The subtle use of oak adds character and depth to the grape with a smooth finish.
